First Reading: Isaiah 43.8-13

⁸ Bring forth the people who are
blind, yet have eyes, who are deaf,
yet have ears!

⁹ Let all the nations gather together,
and let the peoples assemble. Who
among them declared this, and
foretold to us the former things? Let
them bring their witnesses to justify
them, and let them hear and say, 'It
is true.'

¹⁰ You are my witnesses, says
the Lord, and my servant whom I
have chosen, so that you may know
and believe me and understand that
I am he. Before me no god was
formed, nor shall there be any after
me.

¹¹ I, I am the Lord, and besides me
there is no saviour.

¹² I declared and saved and
proclaimed, when there was no
strange god among you; and you
are my witnesses, says the Lord.

⁴³ The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, 'Follow me.' ⁴⁴ Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. ⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found him about whom Moses in the law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus son of Joseph from Nazareth.' ⁴⁶ Nathanael said to him, 'Can anything good come out of Nazareth?' Philip said to him, 'Come and see.' ⁴⁷ When Jesus saw Nathanael coming towards him, he said of him, 'Here is truly an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!' ⁴⁸ Nathanael asked him, 'Where did you come to know me?' Jesus answered, 'I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called you.' ⁴⁹ Nathanael replied, 'Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!' ⁵⁰ Jesus answered, 'Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than these.' ⁵¹ And he said to him, 'Very truly, I tell you, you will see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man.'
